


## Follow these rules to prevent livestock diseases



◇Do not enter a barn and a nearby area if you have entered into Japan from other countries within the previous seven days. If it is unavoidable, take necessary measures such as washing a body, changing clothes etc.








- ♦ Do not bring objects that are not necessary for taking care of animal into the barn.
- Wash or disinfect the object that has been used in another livestock facility before bringing it into the barn.





- Do not bring clothes and shoes that have been used outside Japan within a certain period(\*1) into a barn and a nearby area. If it is unavoidable, take necessary measures, such as washing and disinfecting of the object, before bringing it into the area.
- Disinfect your hands and shoes and change clothes when you enter a barn and a nearby area as needed.



\*1: Regarding Cattle, buffalo, deer, sheep, goat, Pig and wild boar farmers ··· 4 months
Regarding Chicken, duck, quail, pheasant, ostrich, guinea fowl and turkey farmers ··· 2 months
